**Resolution for Town of Sanborn for Electors to Adopt the Town Tax Levy at Special Town Meeting of the Electors**

Whereas, s. 60.10(1)(a) of Wis. Statutes authorizes the town electors of a town to adopt the town tax levy at a town meeting of the electors;

Whereas, a special town meeting of the electors has been called for this 22nd day of November, 2022;

Whereas, the electors after proper notice have with a special town meeting vote authorized the Town of Sanborn to exceed the allowable state levy limit;

Now, therefore, the special town meeting of the Town of Sanborn, Ashland County, Wisconsin, by a majority vote of the eligible electors voting on this 22nd day of November, 2022 duly assembled and voting resolves and orders as follows:

BE IT RESOLVED, the town electors of the Town of Sanborn, Ashland County, Wisconsin hereby adopt the town tax levy for 2022 (to be collected in 2023) in the amount of \$181920 plus \$101406 in long term debt for a total Town Tax Levy of \$283326.

The town clerk shall properly post this resolution in 3 places or publish this resolution once in a qualified newspaper as required by law under s. 60.80 of Wis. Statutes within 30 days of adoption.



The Town of Sanborn will not be using the higher tax levy of \$181920 for 2023. Instead, the Town will be using the allowable levy limit of \$156920 plus long term debt service of \$101406 for a total of \$258326 due to not specifically specifying the actual amount of the \$25000 increase in the resolution per the WI DOR. The 2023 budget will be adjusted to reflect change.
