Resolution for Town of Sanborn for Electors to Adopt the Town Tax Levy at Special Town Meeting of the Electors

Whereas, s. 60.10(1)(a) of Wis. Statutes authorizes the town electors of a town to adopt the town tax levy at a town meeting of the electors;

Whereas, a special town meeting of the electors has been called for this 13th day of December, 2017:

Whereas, the electors after proper notice have with a special town meeting vote authorized the Town of Sanborn to exceed the allowable state levy limit;

Now, therefore, the special town meeting of the Town of Sanborn, Ashland County, Wisconsin, by a majority vote of the eligible electors voting on this 13th day of December, 2017 duly assembled and voting resolves and orders as follows:

BE IT RESOLVED, the town electors of the Town of Sanborn, Ashland County, Wisconsin hereby adopt the town tax levy for 2017 (to be collected in 2018) in the amount of \$159366 plus \$122166.00 long term debt for a total Town tax levy of \$281532.00.

The town clerk shall properly post this resolution in 3 places or publish this resolution once in a qualified newspaper as required by law under s. 60.80 of Wis. Statutes within 30 days of adoption.
